### *Data Collection & Randomization Implementation*

- Lead data coordinator for \$4 million Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration grant (SM89094) for a Certified Community Behavioral Health Clinic in Indiana
- Ongoing management of 525+ patients, their live EHR data, and 799 National Outcomes Measures (NOMs) records
- Implementation and operationalization of randomization across 28 clinical sites and 200 clinical providers
- Personally conducted 59 follow-up interviews from vulnerable populations in a 14-week period
- Operationalized complex SAMHSA criteria into protocol documents to appropriately capture patient information from EHR

- Coordinated regular meetings with partners to maintain cohesion of thought for publication

### *Transcription & Qualitative Coding*

- Cleaned, formatted, and verified the accuracy of 21 raw transcripts (approx. 16 hours of video interviews) related to Medtronic Cardiac Devices

- Produced an initial qualitative codebook for interviews of mental health professionals around trauma-informed care within digital MH technologies, and feedback in final codebook development
- Maintained HIPPA compliance and interviewer/interview confidentiality through PIH redaction
- Developed guidelines for transcription processes – both as a reference within the project and as potential standardized training for future projects
- Presented primary findings of transcribed data within interdepartmental meetings to foreshadow potential significant results and future project direction
