

Prioritization Overview

After gathering and analyzing the data – including applying additional weighting to survey responses from individuals identified as part of vulnerable populations – Professional Resource Consultants (PRC), Senior Leadership and the Board used a structured process to pinpoint the community’s most urgent health needs. This process was meant to be inclusive and data-driven, ensuring that the chosen priorities represented both community members’ experiences and health trends. The process involved meetings with community stakeholders and final selection of top health needs by hospital leaders.

Community Prioritization Sessions

- Carried out between March 2025 and November 2025.
- Key Informant Attendees were selected based on community roles and knowledge with area health needs. A selection of approximately 146 were invited to participate.
- Attendees were professionals who provide a wide range of services to the community from diverse backgrounds.
- Attendees were provided an opinion survey with such topics as major current community needs, gaps in service and perceptions.
- Results were presented for prioritization.

Selected Health Priorities

PRC presented in-depth survey findings and a summary to Logansport Senior Leaders, Logansport Quality Team members, Parkview Community Benefit Team and Parkview Health Improvement Team. Discussion concerning health prioritization and needs occurred. The teams reached a consensus and listed recommendations on health priorities. These recommendations were submitted to the Logansport Board of Directors prior to the monthly board meeting for consideration and review. On November 24, 2025 the Board approved the following health priorities.
