SERVICES

- **Emergency Department:** Full-service, 24-hour department with 10 emergency treatment rooms and two trauma rooms
- **Family Birthing Center:** Seven private labor/delivery/recovery/postpartum rooms, two triage rooms, dedicated C-section suite for enhanced safety with minimal disruption to patient experience, breastfeeding support, 24-hour rooming-in for infant bonding, special care nursery, advanced fetal monitoring system, supportive services for expectant and new moms
- **Diagnostic Imaging:** State-of-the-art equipment for 3D mammography, CT, ultrasound, fluoroscopy, and bone density, plus MRI, HeartSmartCT scan, and routine radiology
- **Outpatient Lab Services:** In-house testing of coagulation, urinalysis, hematology, blood gas, and chemistry tests; certified clinical laboratory scientist on staff 24 hours a day
- **Rehabilitation Services:** Outpatient physical, occupational, and sports medicine therapies
- **Specialty Clinics:** Providing access to services by specialty physicians, including an anticoagulation therapy unit (ATU) to assist warfarin patients and monitor blood-thinner-medication dosing
- **Parkview Physicians Group:** Primary care services and specialty physicians on campus
- **Parkview Packnett Family Cancer Institute:** Seven exam rooms and nine infusion bays, seven of which overlook a Healing Garden
- **Pharmacy**
- **Surgery:** Two surgical suites and two procedure rooms to support inpatient and outpatient surgical needs
- **Outpatient Services:** Outpatient heart monitors, EKGs, Cardiopulmonary Rehab, cardiac stress tests, and more
- **ATU Walk-in Clinic:** Assists warfarin patients and monitors blood-thinner-medication dosing



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
